

TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
7:00 P.M. MONDAY, APRIL 6, 2009
MINUTES

The Mayor and all Councilmen were present.

Mayor Carver called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

Councilman Smith gave the invocation.

Councilman Hudson made a motion to accept agenda. Councilman Miller seconded the motion. All in favor. The agenda was approved.

Councilman Smith made a motion to approve the minutes of the Council meeting held on March 2, 2009 as presented. Councilman Hudson seconded the motion. All in favor and the minutes were approved as presented.

Citizens Input

Ms. Maredel Ray, a town citizen, voiced her concern with the progress on the Wagon House. Mayor Carver let everyone know that we still had one park left to complete which included the wagon house.

Department Reports

Fire Department – FD is waiting on quote from the insurance company for a policy to adequately cover the department's equipment. The FD is still responding to medical calls only if the EMS unit is not in the area. A meeting with Sheriff Hunt and the Chief's Association to determine a path forward was canceled.

Police Department – See Report – Councilman Hudson would like to know if any action was taken concerning the gun shots fired on the past Saturday night around 1:00 am. Chief Key stated no one would talk. Chief Key advised the citizens that anytime they heard gun shots to call 911. Mayor Carver suggested the WPD change up their weekend patrol routine.

Parks – Councilman Miller reported new street signs were being made through Aiken County.

Buildings- No Input.

Water Department –

Jo Branch, water clerk, stated March billing included 3 new customers, 24 calls and 1 turn off .We had no payment extensions.

New Business

Mayor Carver informed everyone that the town will be co-hosting a Veterans Memorial Day Celebration with the Wagener Garden Club and the Wagener Downtown Development Committee.
